MEMORIAL FIELD RULES

Made pursuant to paragraph 26 of the Constitution of Alveston Village Association ("the AVA") dated the 22nd November 2023.

Breach of any of these rules may result in temporary or permanent exclusion from the Memorial Field.

1. Access to and use of the Memorial Field is limited to members of the AVA (as defined in the constitution) their families and guests.
2. No person using or visiting the Memorial Field shall do anything which shall cause nuisance or annoyance to other users or to occupiers of any nearby properties. In particular the following are strictly prohibited:
 - (a) the use of any motorised or powered vehicle of any description (save for mobility vehicles)
 - (b) climbing on boundary walls, fences or hedges
 - (c) camping, lighting fires or littering
3. Dog walking is allowed and encouraged but with a limit of two dogs per person. There shall be no "commercial" dog walking. It is a strict requirement that all dog walkers shall "pick up" and leave no waste in the field.
4. The Memorial Field is naturally maintained as a field not a public thoroughfare. All users therefore are at their own risk and must take reasonable care to avoid injury on the uneven surfaces. The AVA accepts no responsibility or liability for injuries or damage howsoever caused.
5. Children of users and their guests must be accompanied and supervised by adults at all times.
6. There shall be no access to the memorial Field from dusk to dawn.
7. Access to The Memorial Field will be closed for 24 hours on the first Monday in February each year.
